1. Education – Parental choice should be expanded through tax credits ~~of \$1,000~~ to allow children to attend any public, private, religious or home school. (S) O U

2. Health – Federal funds should be used ~~for medical research involving human embryos~~. S (O) U

3. Health – Physician-assisted suicide for terminally ill patients should be legalized. (S) O U

4. Health – Cloning of human embryos for all purposes should be allowed, ~~including the creation and trafficking of cloned human embryos, both embryonic and experimental~~. S (O) U

5. Health – Morning After Pills (emergency contraception) should be available to all women without a doctor's prescription. (S) O U

8. Judiciary – Congress should consider the selective removal of the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts when they fail to observe the separation of powers. S (O) U

9. Judiciary – Federal judges should rely on the law of foreign jurisdictions when construing the laws of the United States. S (O) U

10. Abortion – Abortion should be prohibited, except when the life of the mother is in danger. S (O) U


11. Abortion – It should be a felony for anyone to take a minor across state lines to obtain an abortion in violation of ~~parents~~ parental involvement ~~law~~. (S) O U

12. Taxes – The burden of ~~income~~ income taxes on ~~married~~ ^{people} couples ("marriage penalty"), which ~~occurs when a couple marries~~, should be permanently eliminated. (S) O U

13. Gay Rights – Discrimination law should protect an employee's sexual orientation in the same way as race, religion, age, sex and ancestry are protected. S O U *

14. Gambling – Federal law should be changed to prohibit tribal casino gambling. S (O) U

15. Pornography – Existing laws prohibiting the sale and distribution of obscene materials should be aggressively enforced. S (O) U
